

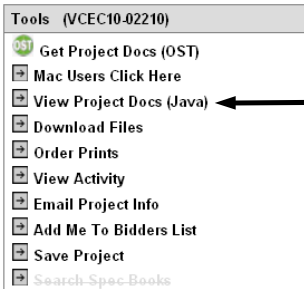
Online Planroom Tips & Tidbits

JAVA VIEWER

One of the many ways to view Project Docs in the Online Planroom.

Not as many bells and whistles as On-Screen Takeoff but it's always good to have options.

***If the instructions below don't work, you might need to install or update Java, found on "Install Software" page.*



To launch the Java Viewer, click "View Project Docs (Java)" from the "Tools" box on a specific project's detail page.

The "Save" option saves any plans you've 'loaded' as a lump TIF file. You choose location & name the file.

"Print" function prints all or specified pages available from what you've 'loaded'.
NOTE: They're always 'fit to page'.

Several zoom, rotate, flip options at the top of the view area.

VIEWING SPECS/PLANS:

To view a PDF file, click the file name and it should open automatically in Adobe.

To view several plans (TIF), click the box next to the file and then click "Load Documents" under the document tree. Click any of the thumbnails that appear and the plan will be shown in the viewing area.

(as shown in the example)
Or to more quickly view a single plan, you can click on the plan file name and it'll appear in the viewing area (no thumbnails).

This is the "Viewing Area" referenced in the instructions to the left.

You can change the viewing area display, including position of thumbnails, using icons in the bottom left corner.

The blue "i" icon includes info about the plan in view, including page size.
